Mark your calendars for **March 12, 2008 at 7:00 p.m.** for the Camp Information Night which will be held in the school cafeteria. Here you will find out about all of the fun and exciting things that we have planned for our summer together.

The camp will be in session from **June 30, - August 22, 2008.** The camp runs Monday-Friday from 8:30-3:30. We also offer a Before Care Program and an After Care Program. The hours are as follows: Before Care 7:30-8:30 and After Care from 3:30-6:00.

Please find the different options for signing up your child for camp:

**All eight weeks for \$1,400. 00**  
**Specific weeks with a minimum of two at \$175.00 per week.**  
**"Pick Your Own Days" with a minimum of 10 at \$40.00 per day.**

There will also be a half-day option for pre-school through first grade children. If there are two or more siblings, you will receive a 5% discount off the tuition. If there are three or more siblings attending, you will receive a 10% discount off the tuition. The camp fee includes a camp T-shirt, camp activities, crafts supplies and fees for all trips. **Camp will close at 3:00 on August 22nd, the last day of camp. There will not be camp on Friday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2008 and camp will close at 3:00 on Thursday, July 3, 2008.**

Our staff includes licensed teachers, many of whom are from our school. There are also assistant teachers. The campers will participate in various activities such as Arts and Crafts, Music and Sports. In addition to these activities we will have special snacks and trips to the park.

We will also go to the Metuchen Pool each Monday and Friday and trips will be on Thursdays.

There will be an end of the Summer Talent show that parents are welcome to attend. More information will follow before the final week of camp.

Please read the posted enrollment sheet for any other pertinent information. When registered, you will have to fill out some additional forms. **All registration fees, security deposits, and camp fees must be paid before your child can attend camp.**
