We are pleased to announce the introduction of our new web-based keyboarding program *Type to Learn 4: Agents of Information*. This new addition allows our students to practice and perfect critical keyboarding skills at school as well as at home. This program will be available on July 1, 2009 to students entering grades 3-8. System Requirements

Recommended: Intel Processor, 1 GB RAM or more.

Recommended: Pentium 4 or higher; 1.5 GHz processor or faster; 1GB RAM or more; Windows XP Service Pack 2 or better.

Web Browser Requirements: Microsoft Internet Explorer 6 or 7; Firefox 2 and above; Safari 3.1.2 and above. Pop-ups must be allowed for printing. Either cable or DSL Internet connection is necessary (not dialup).

Download/Install:

- Ensure that a person with administrator rights logs on to the PC; access the Internet.
- On the address bar type <http://ttl4.sunburst.com/downloads> scroll down and select Full TTL4 Application - Win - Web Version (1 GB EXE). Save it to the desktop.
- After the program has downloaded exit the Internet and run it from the desktop by double clicking on the icon.
- After the program has installed a shortcut will be placed on the desktop. Click the shortcut to start the program.
- A log in screen appears prompting for a username, password, and account code.
- All students have been advised of their usernames and passwords. The user names consist of first initial and last name. If siblings have the same first initial then the full first name and last name should be used (i.e. smills would be susanmills). Passwords consist of letters and numbers only. No special characters may be used (i.e., /, _, &, =, +).
- The account code for St. Francis Cathedral School is 105419.
