Type to Learn Web-Based Keyboarding Installation

The web-based keyboarding program *Type to Learn 4: Agents of Information* allows our students to practice and perfect critical keyboarding skills at school as well as at home. This program is available to students entering grades 3-8. Below are the system requirements and instructions for a successful installation. System Requirements

Recommended: Intel Processor, 1 GB RAM or more.

Recommended: Pentium 4 or higher; 1.5 GHz processor or faster; 1GB RAM or more; Windows XP Service Pack 2 or better.

Web Browser Requirements: Microsoft Internet Explorer 6 and above; Firefox 2 and above; Safari 3.1.2 and above. Pop-ups must be allowed for printing. Either cable or DSL Internet connection is necessary (not dialup).

Download/Install:

- Ensure that a person with administrator rights logs on to the PC; access the Internet.
- On the address bar type <http://ttl4.sunburst.com/downloads> scroll down and select Full TTL4 Application - Win - Web Version v1.2.1. When prompted click *Save*, select *Desktop* and click *Save* again.
- After the program has downloaded exit the Internet and from the desktop double click on the Type to Learn folder. In the opened folder click on *Extract all files* (on the left panel), click *Next* twice and *Finish*.
- In the opened folder double click the *41212a* icon and click on *Run*.
- Click *Next and I Agree* to accept the Software End User License Agreement and *Install* to begin the installation. Click *Finish* when installation is complete.
- After the program has installed a shortcut will be placed on the desktop. Click the shortcut to start the program.
- A log in screen appears prompting for a username, password, and account code.
- All students have been advised of their usernames and passwords. The user names consist of first initial and last name. If siblings have the same first initial then the full first name and last name should be used (i.e. smills would be susanmills). The account code for St. Francis Cathedral School is 105419.
- Due to maintenance, the program will be unavailable from August 15th to August 31st.
